- What is the maximum capacity of CAMPOTINTO Lodge?

The maximum capacity of the Lodge is 10 adults and 5 children.

- What is the best time of the year to visit CAMPOTINTO?

CampoTinto Lodge is open all year long. It's equipped with the best heating and air conditioning systems so that you can enjoy either winter or summer.

The best time of the year to visit us is spring or autumn, when the weather is warm and you can spend a beautiful time around the vineyards. In spring you'll experience an explosion of green shades coming from the vineyards and gardens; and autumn has its mystique, mainly because it is the harvest and wine elaboration season.

- Is the lodge child-friendly?

Yes, of course. We have the necessary accommodations to receive children. We have extra beds and cradles. The San Roque countryside is a very quiet place where children can play freely in the gardens and vineyards. The swimming pool is surrounded by a fence.

- Is the infrastructure of the location suitable for handicapped people?

Yes, the lodge was built including all suitable ramps and facilities.

- Do you accept pets?

Yes, we accept dogs of nonaggressive breeds, provided that the owners accept to sign a disclaimer detailing the behavior of the dog.

- Can you make a brief description of the rooms?

All Standard rooms have 25 m² and a view of the Chapel of San Roque.

One of the Suites has 26m² and a private patio of 18m² with a view to the gardens. The other Suite has 34m² and a view to the gardens.

The Premium Suite is a tent of 45m² on the inside and 30m² in the open air with an exquisite view to the vineyards. It also has a private bonfire to enjoy the stars at night.

All our rooms are equipped with private bathroom, 32" TV, satellite television, air conditioning and heating systems, hair dryer, luggage stand, iPod player, wireless phone, hypoallergenic duvet and pillows, and minibar.

- What are the regular working days and hours of the restaurant?

For guests, the restaurant is open every day; we offer breakfast, lunch, afternoon snack and dinner. The restaurant will remain closed for general public every Tuesday.

- How do I get to CAMPOTINTO?

There are 4 different ways to get to **CAMPOTINTO**:

By car: If you are travelling from Buenos Aires, it's a 4:30-hour trip. You have to drive through the border crossing point Gualeguaychu - Fray Bentos; then take the R21 to Carmelo. If you are travelling from Montevideo, you have to drive 3hs through route 1 and then take R21 to Carmelo.

By Buquebus: Carmelo and **CAMPOTINTO** Lodge are located 50 minutes from the Port of Colonia del Sacramento.

By La Cacciola: It's a comfortable ship that travels from the Port of Tigre, Provincia de Buenos Aires to the Port of Carmelo; it's a 2:30-hour trip. This option will take you on an entertaining trip around the Paraná Delta. CampoTinto Lodge is located 5 minutes from the Port of Carmelo.

By private plane: If you depart from San Fernando Airport (Prov. de Buenos Aires, Argentina) it will only take 10 minutes to arrive to Carmelo Airport; **CAMPOTINTO** Lodge is located 5 minutes from the airport. We have frequent contact with an air taxi operator that has planes of different sizes in order to satisfy the needs of our customers.

- What is the distance from CAMPOTINTO:

Carmelo? 3.5 km

the airport? 5.5 km

Colonia? 70 km

Montevideo? 230 km

Punta del Este? 360 km

- What is the weather like in Carmelo?

It is similar to the weather in Buenos Aires. Very hot in the summer, fresh and quite pleasant during autumn and spring, and cold in winter. The seasons of the year mark the rhythm and the lifestyle of the countryside creating an atmosphere that changes throughout the year. Each season has its charms.

- What activities are available in Carmelo?

We have Trek bikes at your disposal, we organize picnics and barbecues in the vineyards, tours to the wineries and wine tasting, tours to different tourist attractions around the area (Calera de Las Huérfanas, Narbona Chapel, Chapel of San Roque, Beaches)



The **CAMPOTINTO** Lodge SPA will be inaugurated on 2014, together with the conference room. Masseurs and stretchers are available if our guests shall require such services. Temporarily, all treatments are performed in the rooms.

**One of the best 18-hole golf courses in Uruguay is located 4km from our lodge.
Polo fields and schools are 4km away from our location.
We also have a tennis court.**

-What's the most significant wine variety of the region?

The signature grape is Tannatas well as the white varieties (Chardonnay, Viognier, and Sauvignon Blanc). You can find all these grapes in Carmelo, considered a unique terroir that produces top quality wines.

- Do I need a VISA to travel to Uruguay?
